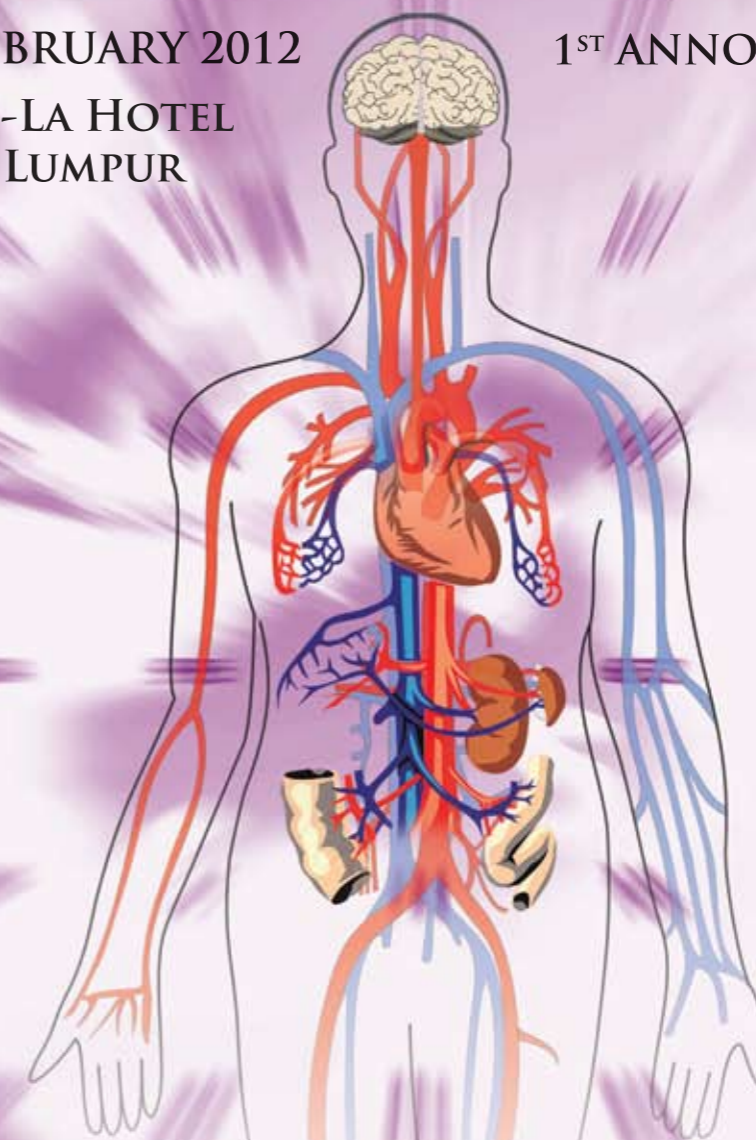

These are some of the issues which we will be addressing during this upcoming scientific meeting.


I would also like to encourage our local researchers to present their studies at this meeting. Clinicians are increasingly looking for local evidence and data in helping
